

MASS ATTENDANCE

5:30 9:00 12:15 **84 127 289** For the pastor message this week, I simply would like to remind you and encourage everyone take part in as much of the Sacred Triduum and liturgies of Holy Week as possible.

Firstly, on Monday, April 10th at 6pm, the Diocese will gather with the Bishop at Sacred Heart Cathedral for the Chrism Mass. This is a beautiful Mass wherein the Bishop blesses the sacred oils that will be used in the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, Ordination and Anointing of the Sick in the up-coming year. Also during this Mass the priests of the diocese renew their Ordination promises in front of the diocesan community.

On Thursday, April 13th at 7pm, at each of our parishes (St Peter, St Patrick, and St John) we will celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper or Holy Thursday. At this Mass, we will recall the Lord's demonstration of service and humility with the Washing of Feet and the Institution of the Holy Eucharist which occurred on this night.

On Friday, April 14th at 7pm, at each of our parishes we will have a Good Friday liturgy, where we will venerate the Holy Cross, the instrument of our salvation, and participate in Liturgy of the Word with Holy Communion service. Good Friday is the only day of the entire year were no Mass is celebrated.

On Saturday, April 15th, at 8p, we will have the Holy Saturday Easter Vigil at our parishes. At this Mass we will welcome our catechumens into the Catholic faith; they will receive Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion. We will also welcome the Resurrected Christ into our hearts once again.

Finally, on Sunday April 16th, at the normal Mass times, we will have Easter morning Masses and will commemorate the Resurrection of Christ.

I realize that although it is such a sacred and holy time in our faith and in our parishes, our world keeps moving ahead full steam. But please try to make an effort to attend at least some of these liturgies. These liturgies outline the central aspects of our faith. They shape our relationship with God that we experience throughout the whole year.

I pray you have a very holy Holy Week. God Bless.
