I have a cousin. I have a lot of cousins. But I have one in particular his name is Jopie. His real name is John Paul but we call him Jopie. I don't even know why, but we do. Anyway, he is my younger cousin.

One time he was talking to his mom. He was a young boy and I think he had just had a birthday so he was feeling old and mature. And I don't remember the exact request that she made of him, but she basically told him a certain way he was going to do something in his life, and to her he responded, "don't tell me, I'm a grown-*** man."

Yes he even included an explicative in that response to his mother.

Can you believe that?

Now normally, his mother, and I know her well (my aunt) would have popped his mouth so hard with the back of her hand his lip would have swollen.

But I think she was so surprised by his abrupt response, all she could do was actually laugh. She burst-out laughing.

Here's this little boy (he was her youngest of hers) attempting to assert his manhood, his independence. It was so ridiculous is was comical.

He is lucky, he got off easy that time.

Anyway, the reason I bring this up is because of the Gospel. Did you hear what Jesus did in the Gospel???

Jesus laughed. He laughed at the ridiculousness of the mindset of people. The Gospel says Jesus "exclaimed" ... which is not a good translation. Other translations say he "rejoiced in the Spirit" and said "I give praise to you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, for although you have hidden these things from the wise and learned you have revealed them to little ones."

Have you ever heard the saying "if you want to make God laugh, tell him your plans?" That is basically true.

Jesus laughed in the Gospel today because people who think they get it and have it all figured out do not, but people who are little and small and simple, they get it. Jesus laughed at the mindset of those people who think they got it all figured out just like my aunt laughed at my cousin when as a little idiot kid he thought he had it all figured out because he was now a grown-*** man.

The funny thing about life is that no matter how big and successful we may become, no matter how talented or how many degrees we may have, we are entirely dependent upon God just like my little cousin was dependent on his mother...actually we are even more dependent than that.

And the simple, the little, the humble...they get it. That is what it means to be child-like. Not childish (which is a whole other problem). But yes, child-like. Because we are in fact children to God.
