I always laugh a little bit when I read about how the Israelites acted in the desert. I do not laugh at them in a derogatory way...rather I laugh at how perfectly they exemplify human nature in general...a human nature we all share.

The first reading said the Israelites "grumbled" against Moses. They were slaves in Egypt and God set them free by leading them out through many miracles and demonstrations of God's power. How amazing for God to help them in this way!

But how quickly they start to grumble when things get a little tough.

Like I said, I'm not criticizing them per se, I just think it's amazing how much we are exactly the same today. People are people...as my grandfather likes to say.

God does many amazing things for us. How many blessing we have in our lives?!?!?! How much God spoils us with provisions, shelter, clothing, companionship, etc...jobs, hobbies, cars, nice weather....etc...not to mention the amazing faith He has invited us into...

And yet, if it's 2pm and we haven't eaten lunch yet, we get short, snippy. That blood sugar drops and look out...

Our nature is remarkably weak. God must look at us like we look at a newborn crying for milk.

When we keep this in mind, it helps us to be humble. And when we are humble, it makes it easier to encounter God. I hope everyone is getting a little time during this Lent to sit back and reflect upon all the blessings God has given us. It will help us blow off the smaller inconveniences we all experience in life and will we have, overall, more peace and authentic joy. Just like it was for the Israelites, it is for us: it could be a whole lot worse...
