Please continue to pray for him and for all the seminarians as they pursue God's call to follow Him. It is a very counter-cultural commitment and supernatural vocation. It takes tons of grace (help from God).

Now that he has left I can comment on him and the other seminarians and not be an occasion towards tempting them to pride.

We have had three seminarians in recent years and it is encouraging to witness their faith and love for the Church. There was a time in our Diocese and in many places that vocations to the priesthood was not pursued and even discouraged, and the effects were detrimental.

But slowly and surely, God has been inspiring young men to sacrifice their lives for His Bride the Church.

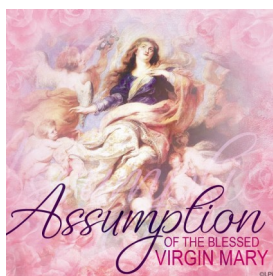
