Pastor message

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

As we spoke of last week, we are conducting a Capital Campaign here at St John.

If you look in the back of Church you can see what our plan is to increase the beauty of our sanctuary. In addition to the beautiful updates to the sanctuary, we also plan to do a number of practical maintenance items around the parish that need attention. This includes: recovering the pews in the church, replacing the carpet in the church, replacing carpet in the conference room and offices, upgrading to LED lighting, replacing the kitchen cabinets in the social hall, replacing the sign out front and filling in the cracks in the parking lot and re-sealing.

Our goal is \$195,000. Amazing, we currently have pledged about \$150,000 through the sponsorships of the beautiful Stations of the Cross and the Statues of Mary and Joseph and the Tabernacle altars.

I am very thankful for those who have stepped up and made amazing sacrifices to sponsor these items.

But we are not done. We have about \$50k to go that we still need to raise to hit our goal. We are going raise this money by asking you to please sponsor a pew or two. You can sponsor a pew for \$1,200. You can pay right up front or you can make payments of up to 2 years. If you pay over 1 year it's only \$100 per month and if you pay over 2 years it is only \$50 per month. This is in addition to your regular giving at the parish as we still need to pay regular operating expenses.

Please consider sponsoring a pew or two. You can sponsor them in memorial of a loved one. We will put a sign on each pew that says "Pray for (name of loved one)"

There are pledge cards in this bulletin. Please let me know if you have any questions. I am grateful to all you do to make our parish a holy, beautiful and well-kept spiritual home.
