

A little History about Our Lady of Guadalupe

Through the centuries, many Popes have recognized the significance of the story of and image of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Among the most important papal recognitions are the following:

- . Pope Benedict XIV, in the Papal Bull Non Est Equidem, date May 25, 1754, declared Our Lady of Guadalupe patron of "New Spain."
- .Pope Leo XIII authorized Canonical Coronation of the image, which occurred on October 12, 1895.
- · Pope Pius X proclaimed Our Lady of Guadalupe the patron of Latin America in 1910.
- · Pope Pius XII entitled Our Lady of Guadalupe as "Queen of Mexico and Empress of the Americas" in 1945, and "Patroness of the Americas" in 1946.
- · Pope John XXIII entitled Our Lady of Guadalupe as "Mother of the Americas" in 1961.
- 'Pope Paul VI sent a Golden Rose to the shrine on March 20, 1966, as a token of reverence.
- · Pope John Paul II visited the shrine on January 26, 1979, and beatified Juan Diego there on May 6, 1990.
- · Pope Francis made an apostolic visit to the shrine on February 13, 2016, granting the shrine a gold-plated silver crown with the inscription "Mater Mea, Spes Mea" ("My Mother and My Hope").
