

Today for the pastor message I have one very important thing I would like every single person to do.

PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE signup to receive emails from the Virginia Catholic Conference.

Recently I gave a homily about the awful things the Virginia Generally Assembly is trying to make law here in Virginia, including striping away protections of unborn babies by encouraging abortion, making it legal for a doctor to kill a patient through physician assisted suicide, forcing Catholic adoption agencies to close because of state rules that violate our religious beliefs, and removing scholarships for low income children to attend Catholic schools.

Most of this stuff passes and you never even hear about it. Sign up at the Virginia Catholic Conference so you know what is going on. They are the Diocese sponsored Catholic advocacy group. They can help you know what is going on and also let you know how you can make demands of your state representatives.
