

Message of the Bishop, from the Desk of the Administrator



WE ARE LOOKING FOR SACRISTANS

We are planning to start a new ministry as a sacristan. The sacristan would be responsible for setting up and cleaning up after the weekend Masses. It would require coming to church at least one-half hour before Mass begins in order to set up the vessels (ciborium, chalice, etc) and to clean up after Mass [removing the vessels from the altar to the sacristy, washing them and putting them away).
