Dear parishioners,

I am writing this Parochial Vicar's Point of View (PVPV) from Harrisonburg as I attend our annual diocesan Priest Convocation. It has been a great blessing to be here with my fellow priests. By the time you read this, I will, God willing, be back in Richmond with many of you. Our speaker during this convocation is an excellent presenter and theologian, Dr. Ralph Martin, who is inspiring me to write a few words about what *all this* is all about. By "all this" I am referring to going to church, listening to the scriptures, receiving the Sacraments, living out the faith, etc. What is the point? What is *all this* about?

Well, I think in a very real way, *all this* is meant to help strengthen you, to help prepare you for the realities of life. Life out there is tough. Life out there includes all sorts of good and bad things. And some of those bad things are really, really bad! We need Him in prayer, in scripture, and in His sacraments. He is our strength to withstand the crush of the world. And He is the means of our thriving, because He conquered death. Praised be Jesus Christ, now and forever!
