

#### From the Administrator's Desk

Coming Wednesday, 8th of December, is the Solemn Feast of the **Immaculate Conception of Mary**, a holyday of Obligation of the church.

It is a feast of the universal church always celebrated in ADVENT and proclaimed by Pope Pius IX in 1854 with a papal encyclical **INEFFABILIS DEUS**, referring to the conception of Mary in the womb of St. Anna her mother, devoid of any original sin inherited by humanity due to the sin of disobedience of our first parents, Adam and Eve, in the garden of Eden. Thus, the pope's Dogma of declaration is as follows:

"The most blessed virgin Mary in the first instant of her conception, by a singular grace and privilege granted by almighty God, in view of the merits of Jesus Christ, the savior of the human race, was preserved free from all stain of Original sin."

In other words, Mary's Immaculate Conception enhances Jesus' redemptive work, since in her, Jesus's work was so powerful to prevent her from original sin which affected all human race. Again, being addressed full of grace by the angel Gabriel (Lk. 1:28), means she received all the special divine help necessary for her task ahead. Correspondingly she replied: "Behold I am the Handmaid of the Lord be it done to me according to your word" (Lk. 1:38), and the word became flesh and dwelt in her.

Finally, Mary's intimate association with the incarnation called for the involvement of God in her life, hence she was free of sin from the first moment of her existence. This is what is termed the Great Privilege of Mary. Several years later the Blessed Mother appeared to St. Bernadette at Lourdes stating, "I am the Immaculate Conception."

The blessed Mother will be very glad if you don't miss mass on this very day to honor her.
