

Dear friends, today is the *first Sunday in the first month of the year 2022*, and we are all grateful for his graciousness. However, it is very important to ask for the Lord's blessings and his direction to begin the New Year. Apparently, it coincides with the Epiphany of the Lord in which Jesus is revealed or shown as messiah to the entire world (and not only to the Jews) by the presence of the Magi (Caspar, Balthazar and Melchior) from the far East directed by the Star to present their symbolic gifts of Gold (his kingship), Frankincense (his priesthood) and Myrr (his greatness), to the newborn baby, Jesus. (Mt. 2:10-11).
