

Message to end the Christmas Season.

The Baptism of the Lord is the last Sunday to close the Christmas season in the Western church.

It must be noted that Jesus' baptism was not for moral conversion and change of heart but:

- To give an indication how baptism was a primary condition to enter into the king-dom of God (Jn. 3:3ff)
- To sanctify the waters of baptism so as to open the power of baptism to all Christians to be true children of God.
- To reveal the Trinitarian Mystery (the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit) in which every Christian is to be baptized. That is why immediately the Son was baptized and came out of the water, the Spirit of God descended like a dove on him and the voice of the Father was heard saying; "This is my beloved son in whom I am well pleased." (Mt. 3:13ff)

We likewise remember our own baptisms, be it infant of adult, when water was poured on us to wash away our sins by Jesus' blood; anointed with Chrism oil as a sign of our ownership by the Lord; the candle given to us as symbol of Christ's light in us to always guide us and finally the white garment placed on us to signify our new life in Christ Jesus, not to be tainted with dirt (sin). Therefore, by baptism we become God's children obliging us to live lives measuring up to be called children of God.

Let's therefore live by our baptismal promises always. Happy New Year.
