

From Fr. Maxwell's office

Dear Friends.

Exactly a week after the celebration of the mystery of the *Most Holy Trinity*, yet another mystery, *The* Holy Body and Blood of Jesus in the appearance of bread and wine, begueathed to the church as spiritual food of the soul, is also celebrated. This spiritual food is what is called *Corpus Christi* or the Holy Eucharist in theological parlance, as we find in Jesus' own words at the last supper when he gave His body and blood in the form of bread and wine to his apostles saying: "Take and eat, this is my Body.. Take and drink this is my Blood." (Mt. 26:26). Earlier, Jesus had said that it is a nourishment of the soul of the believer for eternal life: "whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life.... for my flesh is true food and my blood is true drink... (Jn. 6:54ff). The Holy Eucharist is therefore the "mystery of faith" and only with faith can one know that at the invocation of the Holy Spirit at the time of the Consecration — which is when the priest says, "This is my body," "This is the cup of my blood" — is the bread and wine changed into the body and blood of Jesus Christ who is really present as God and as Man sacrificing himself for us on the altar.

Having a big reverence for this Eucharistic species, we adore it anytime it is lifted high either in the mass or exposed in the Monstrance at adoration and benediction, for his companionship and blessing in our hearts.

Thanks to Fr. Redmond for his lessons on the Eucharist which has prepared you all for the celebration of the Feast of Corpus Christi, and as a follow up, I invite you all this weekend in all the masses in the various churches, for 15-20 minutes Adoration and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament just after the post-communion prayer, and in all designated days of Adoration, to deepen your faith in Christ, the author of life and savior of the universe, and to pray for the whole world which is engulfed in evil and atrocities these days.

During Adoration you may say this prayer: "Lord, I believe, I adore, I trust, and I love You. I ask pardon for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not trust, and do not love You."

Wishing all Fathers a Blessed Fathers' Day.
