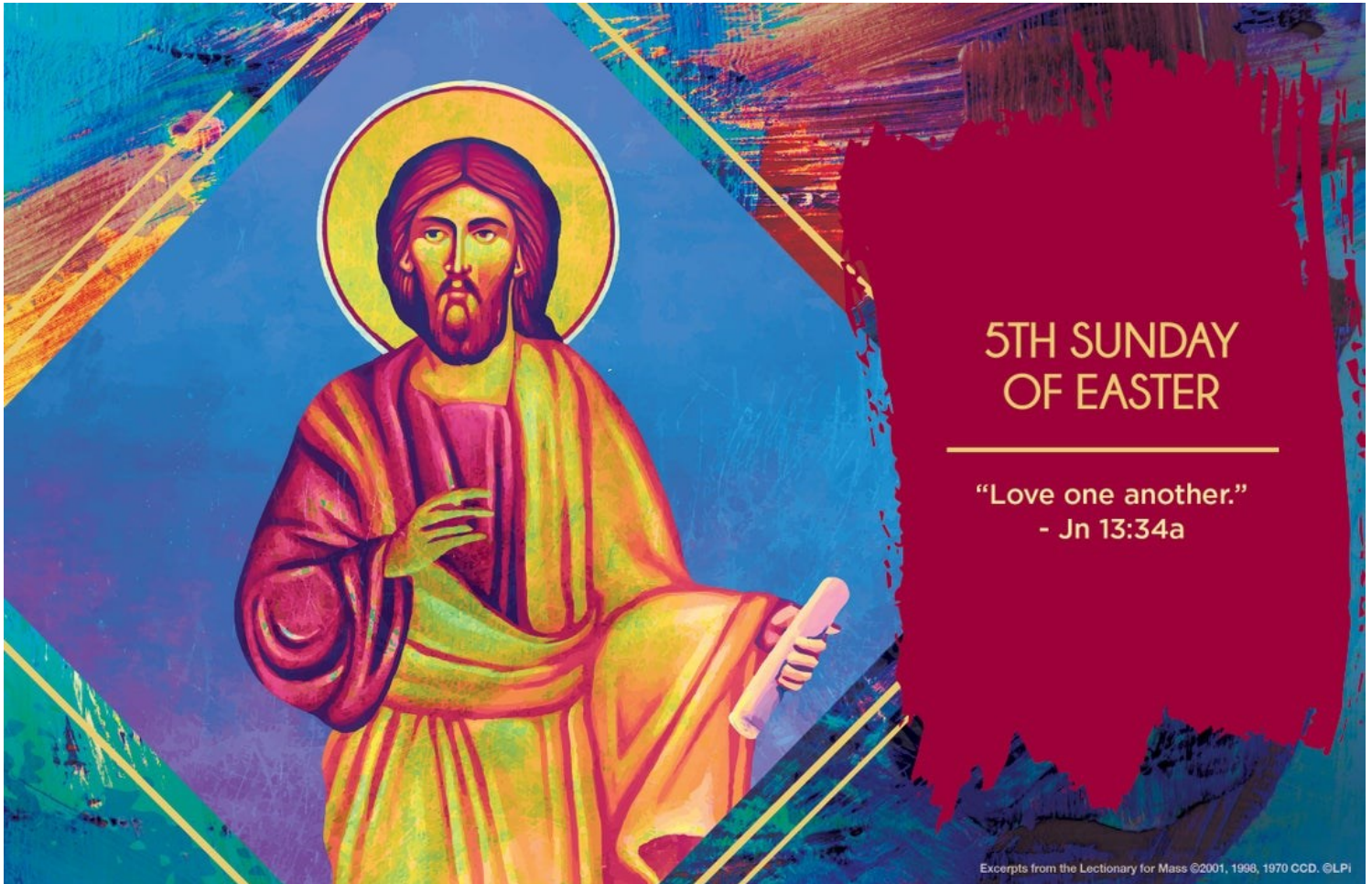

Dear Parishioners,

The Diocesan Annual Appeal this year for the 3-Cluster Churches have been encouraging so far. As of May 10, 2022, this is how the churches have donated so far:

Out of the **\$13,920** Target for St. John Church, the amount raised is **\$10,550** of which **\$9,580** has been collected; whilst St. Patrick with a Target of **\$11,140**, the amount raised is **\$9,355** and the amount collected is **\$7,105**. Finally, St. Peter with a Target of **\$9,580**, having raised an amount of **\$21,088**, collected an amount of **\$21,088** which is more than twice over and above the given Target with only **24** donors.

Thank you all for your generosity. But from the saying; "it is not yet over until all is over," I am pretty sure that both St. John and St. Patrick Churches will certainly meet their given Targets before the fiscal year ends, as I remind those yet to honor their pledges to respectfully do so.

You don't know how much your financial contribution is of great help to the Diocese of Richmond and its Chief Shepherd, Bishop Knestout, who is very grateful and thankful for your kind donation.
