### **From the Pastor's Desk (the value of life)**

Human life is always a precious gift from God and its sanctity from *conception to natural death* is to be *respected and defended* all the time, since it comes from God as his image and imprint. God is therefore the sole Lord of this life because the body belongs to Him (1 Cor.6:19ff), and as such, man cannot do with his life as he wills or dispose of at will (Cf. Pope John Paul II, *Evangelium Vitae*, n. 39). Any attempt to do so is opposing God's love for the human person, and violating the fundamental rights of the Human person. This explains why *march for life* is more about loving God and sharing the Gospel message to love one another (Jn. 13:34)), so as to protect the sanctity of life.

The Baby Bottle campaign is thus a means of raising funds in protecting life and loving families. As of now, out of the bottles picked up during Lent, St. Peter Pro-Cathedral has donated \$1,075.33, whilst St. Patrick church donated \$1,583.82 and St. John church contributed \$2,310.18 respectively.

Thank you all for supporting this year's East End Pregnancy center bottle campaign. God richly bless you for the show of love. As the scripture says: "as you did to the least of your brethren, you did it to me." (Mt. 25:40). However, those who might have forgotten and still have one of the bottles with them at home, are kindly reminded to bring it back.
