We hope that new friends & potential advocates will consider the following volunteer opportunities:

**<u>Call Reassurance Volunteer</u>** - Provide security and companionship to lonely and/or isolated older adults in the community by calling the client on a prearranged schedule.

**Caregiver Relief Volunteer** - Provide relief to full-time caregivers who cannot get out due to caregiving responsibilities. Volunteers provide companionship and social stimulation to care recipients in their home twice per month for 2-3 hours giving the primary caregiver a much needed break.

**<u>Refugee Youth Mentor</u>** - Provide youth one-to-one mentoring with the goal of assisting clients with their education and/or career path.

**Refugee Volunteer Driver** - Help refugees by connecting them to community resources, which requires driving them to and from appointments, classes and interviews.
