At CCC, we rely on the time, talent, & resources of various stakeholders that help us do this absolutely necessary work of serving the vulnerable throughout the Diocese of Richmond. The volunteers who choose to spend their time serving with us are some of our most important stakeholders, friends, & advocates and we would not be able to carry out our mission without them. We hope that new friends & potential advocates will consider the following volunteer opportunities:

Call Reassurance Volunteer - Provide security and companionship to lonely and/or isolated older adults in the community by calling the client on a prearranged schedule.

Caregiver Relief Volunteer - Provide relief to full-time caregivers who cannot get out due to caregiving responsibilities. Volunteers provide companionship and social stimulation to care recipients in their home twice per month for 2-3 hours giving the primary caregiver a much needed break.

Refugee Youth Mentor - Provide youth one-to-one mentoring with the goal of assisting clients with their education and/or career path.

Refugee Volunteer Driver - Help refugees by connecting them to community resources, which requires driving them to and from appointments, classes and interviews.
