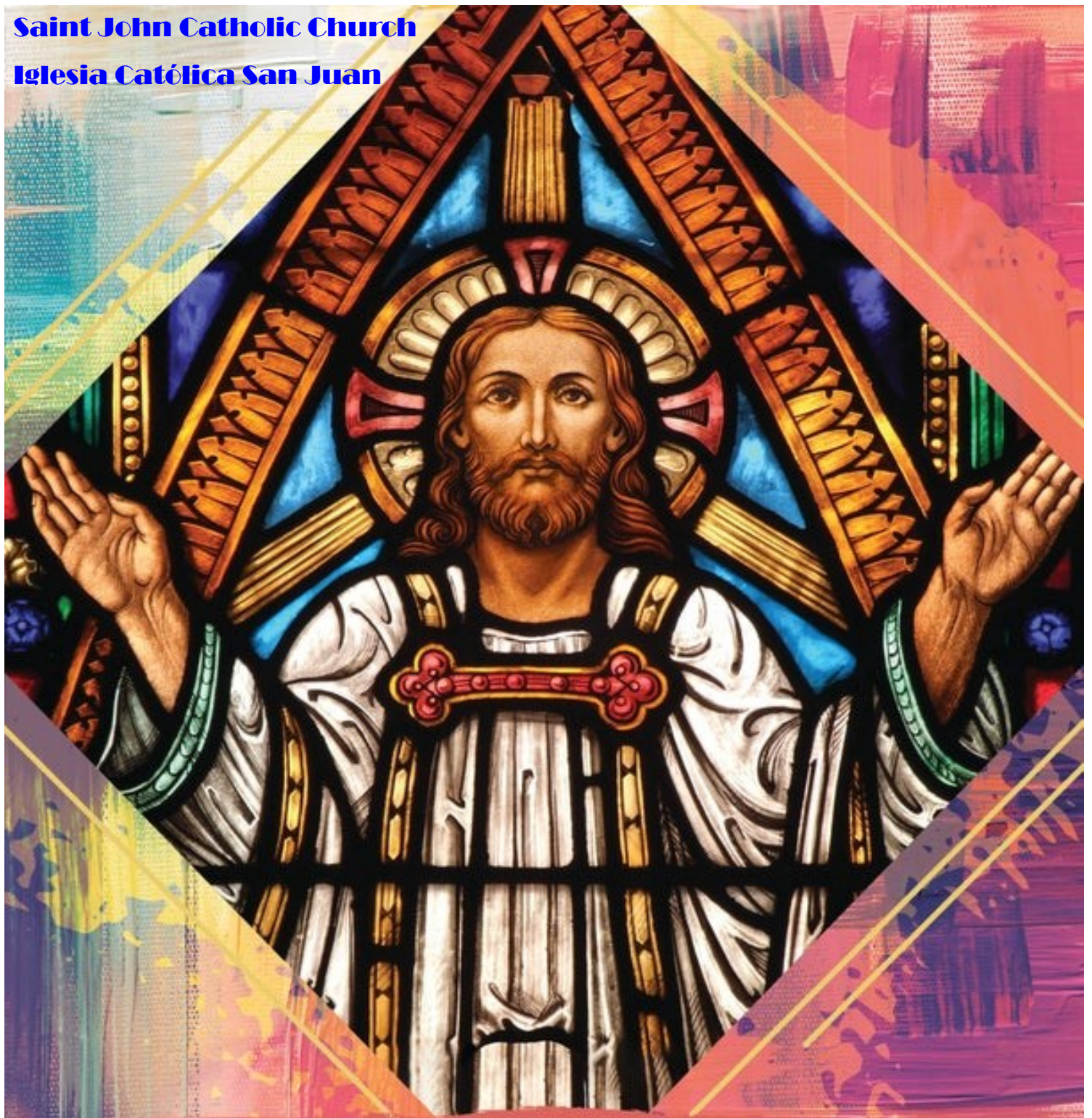

Dear Ones,


Very soon the Church's Liturgical Year (Year C) on its Calendar will be coming to a close with the Feast of Christ the King of the Universe (34th Sunday in Ordinary Time), and a new liturgical year (Year A) will begin with the Advent Season (First Sunday of Advent).

Basically, the Church's Year unfolds through two cycles, the **Temporal cycle** with Christ centered mysteries comprising the seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent, Holy week, Easter, Holy Trinity, Corpus Christi, Sacred Heart, Holy name, Ordinary time ending with Christ the King Feast.

Simultaneously with the temporal cycle is the **Sanctoral cycle** which is the commemoration of the anniversaries or feast days of the saints.

The liturgical year therefore revolves around the person of Jesus Christ relating to his mystery in whom they have their meaning and glory.
