Dear Parishioners,
Just after the Church's yearly celebration of the Christ the King of the universe feast, the North American tradition of celebrating Thanksgiving annually will follow.

Thanksgiving has been a basic theme in many religions throughout history, for instance: Jewish religious traditions included both public and private sacrifices of Thanksgiving.; the word chosen to describe Christians bread and cup memorial ritual of Jesus' resurrection and his continuing presence in the Eucharist in Greek is called Thanksgiving; similarly fast forward in the American history, Thanksgiving Day celebration officially was proclaimed by President George Washington on November 26, 1789, at the authorization of Congress as a day of Thanksgiving though a regular annual celebration did not exist throughout individual states. It was President Abraham Lincoln who proclaimed the last Thursday of November as a day dedicated to praise and thanks to a gracious Father, and was continued every year until Congress passed a legislation in 1941 that the fourth Thursday of November each year be observed as Thanksgiving Day and a National holiday. Since then, it has become a family celebration and a time for families and friends to feast at table with one another to enjoy their bonds of love with a meal together in a festival thanking God for the bounty received from his good graces.

As you travel to be with your various families far and near to observe this annual American tradition, although this day is not part of the universal church calendar year, before your family fellowship, a Thanksgiving mass could be attended to seek God's blessings for the family.

On this note, on behalf of the church I wish all Parishioners a wonderful family reunion and fellowship.
