However, in case someone is not trained for that, but there is the urgent need to take communion after mass in a pyx to a person sick at home who could not be present in church, inform the clergy to let you know what to do (at least you need a simple altar to put the pyx on) before giving communion to the sick person at home. Let us continue to give maximum reverence to the precious species. Praised be Jesus Christ!
