

From the Pastor's Desk

In a couple of days, the Church will be entering into the Holy week, the final preparation for the celebration of the paschal feast beginning from Palm Sunday through the Easter Triduum. Bishop Knestout, is inviting all the faithful in the Diocese to celebrate the Annual Mass of the Oils also called Chrism Mass, taking place on Monday of Holy week at the Cathedral of the Sacred Heart, the Episcopal See of the bishop of Richmond at 6pm.

Mass of the Oils is a special mass in which the bishop joined by his priests across the length and breadth of the diocese, gather at his Cathedral as a sign of unity and communion between them, to manifest this publicly, and renew their commitment to their vocation to the priesthood. It again reminds us of our oneness in Christ and its holy anointing made possible by the mystery of the bishop and his priests as presbyterate, when Oils are blessed for the lay faithful to be used in various sacraments in the church's sacramental life throughout the year, to deepen their understanding of their use and effects. Three Oils are thus blessed; Oil of Catechumen for baptism, Oil of the infirm, anointing of sick for healing and Holy Chrism for baptism, confirmation and Holy orders, as well as for the dedication of a church in which the altar and walls are anointed. The symbolism of the oils is for sanctification, healing, strengthening, consecration and dedication.

As we join the bishop for this annual event, may our hearts turn to our gracious Lord who bestows His infinite love and mercy to us, as we pray for the bishop and his priests, ministers of the sacraments, that they may be humble and generous servants of the Lord.
