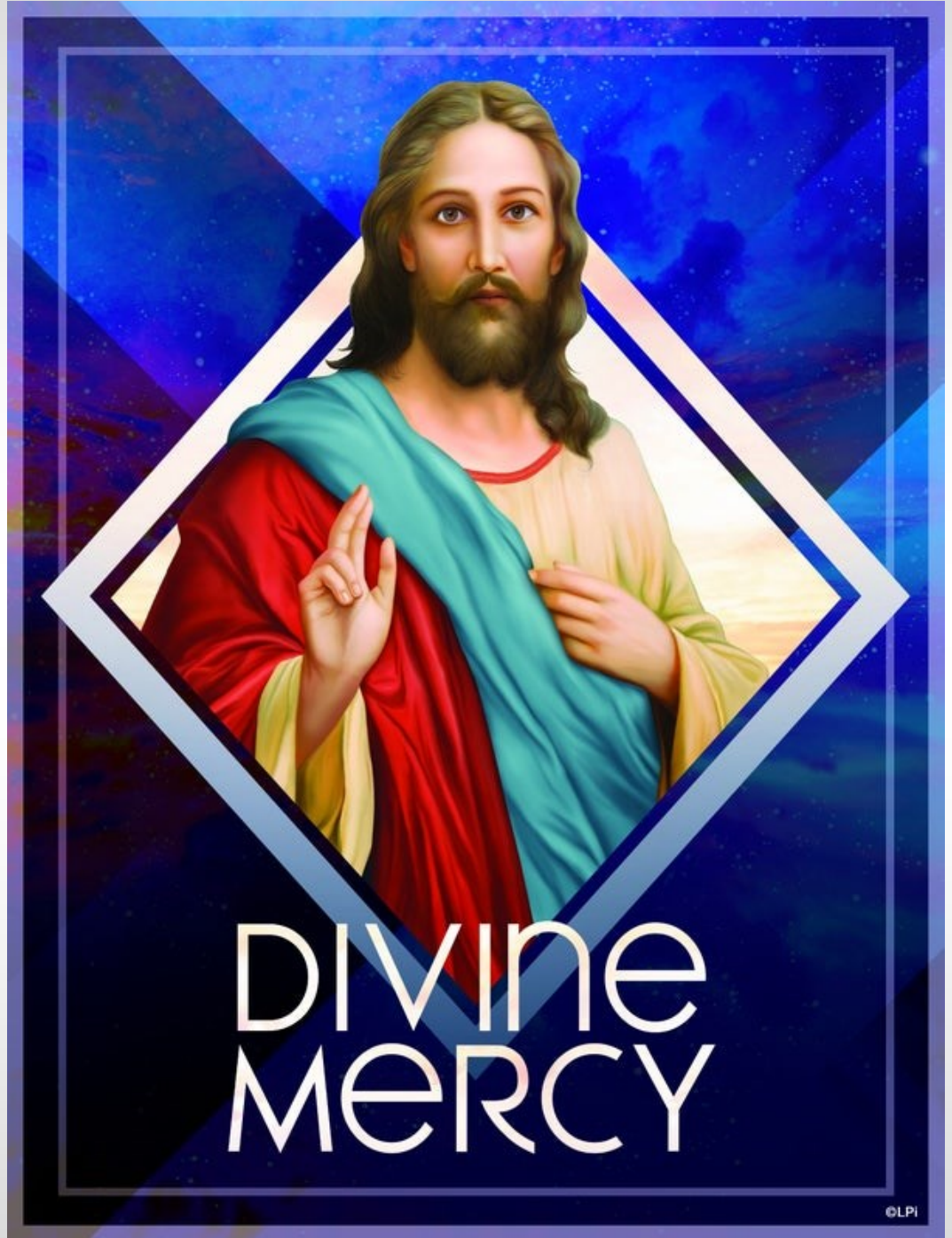

Pope St. John Paul II at the canonization of Sr. Faustina Kowalska, the apostle and secretary of divine mercy in April 30, 2000 declared second Sunday of Easter to be observed worldwide in the church as Divine Mercy Sunday due to the strict link between the "Easter mystery of the Redemption"- the suffering, death, burial, resurrection and ascension of Christ followed by the sending of the Holy Spirit, all showing the Lord's mercy.

The Divine Mercy has now become a popular devotion in the church because of some of these reasons:

- the approach and great trust in Jesus' fathomless mercy
- complete pardon is granted in confession, and receiving Holy communion on the Divine Mercy Feast day
- in venerating the image of the Divine Mercy, our enemies are shattered at our footsteps
- understanding that it is for us that blood and water flowed from Jesus' heart as from a fount overflowing with mercy.
- we are made to be merciful to others through our actions, words and prayers on their behalf.

Through devotion to the Divine Mercy, May the Lord's kingdom come to bring peace in our confused and chaotic world today.

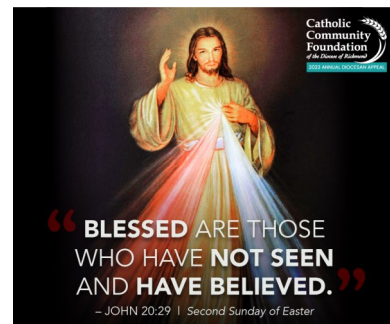
