PASTOR'S WEEKLY REFLECTION

The 5th Sunday in Lent has traditionally been called Passion Sunday, marking the beginning of *Passiontide*. While this language is no longer used in the modern liturgical calendar, the week anticipates the more intense celebrations of Holy Week that begin formally with Palm Sunday. Statues and crosses are veiled to strip away and invite an intense focus on the central action that takes place on the altar, which is a re-presentation of self-offering of Christ on the Cross on Good Friday. All will be unveiled at the beginning of the Solemn Easter Vigil. Please consider making a commitment to attend all or some of the festivities associated with Holy Week - from the Chrism Mass at the Cathedral through the celebrations of the Sacred Tridium. 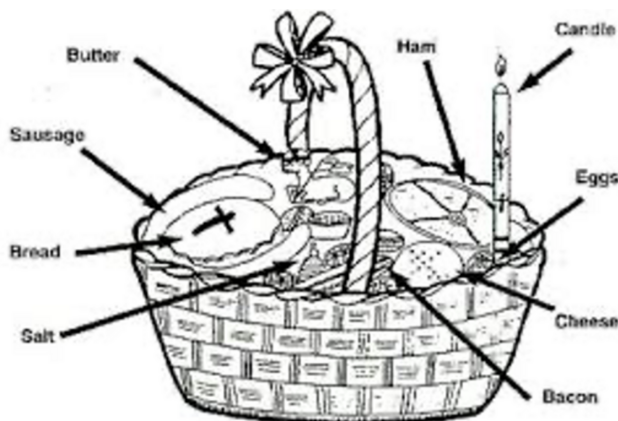

6:00 PM Chrism Mass, Cathedral of the Sacred Heart

This is the annual Mass where the priests renew their promises and the Bishop blesses and consecrates the holy oils (Oil of the Infirm [Anointing of the Sick], Oil of the Catechumens [for those to be baptized], Sacred Chrism [for Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Orders]).

Holy Thursday, March 28th

Mass of the Lord's Supper/ Misa de la Cena del Señor

This is the Mass commemorating the institution of the Most Holy Eucharist and the institution of the Sacred Priesthood, the Mandatum (Washing of the Feet) is traditionally offered following the homily.

Good Friday, March 29th

According to ancient tradition, Mass is forbidden on this day. Instead, there is a Liturgy of the Word, adoration of the Most Holy Cross and distribution of Holy Communion

3:00 PM **Good Friday Passion Liturgy** (Saint Peter)

12:00 PM **Church Hill Ecumenical Stations of the Cross** (Patrick Henry Park)

Holy Saturday, March 30th

The morning of Holy Saturday commemorates the period of the Lord's "descent into hell" as noted in the Apostle's Creed, it marks the death of the Lord and anticipates the resurrection. In the evening, we "vigil" in anticipation of the Resurrection and the Easter Sacraments. The evening Mass is marked by the Easter Fire, blessing of the Paschal Candle, extend Vigil readings, and the celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation.
