## PASTOR'S WEEKLY REFLECTION

We often talk about the incredible *cultural* divide between the *secular* and the *religious*. When it comes to this weekend's feast, maybe there is less of a divide. It is not a big leap for the "worldly" man to think he might be able to "begin again." Today, we celebrate the "eighth day," when the Lord begins creation again, as a result of the Empty Tomb. It is a symbol of "new beginning" when the Lord manifests the application of the merit of the Cross in our lives. He appears completely "new" before the Apostles in the same room where he instituted the priesthood and the Most Holy Eucharist. Now He says: Peace; anxiety and fear no longer have a place within the lexicon of the human condition - we can begin again, daily, *in Him*. The secularist believes this, the difference is that they often say that the "power" to begin again is found from within oneself, by one's own power. The Christian says, the "power" comes from Christ. When I daily pick up my cross, my obligation, my responsibilities and joys, Christ can renew me, refashion me, in His Own Image.

Let's take some time to consider how we might ask him to renew our parish, our communities, our families and our individual souls. Please be assured of my prayers this week.

**Una nota del Párroco** A menudo hablamos de la increíble división cultural entre lo secular y lo religioso. Cuando se trata de la fiesta de este fin de semana, tal vez haya menos división. No es un gran salto para el hombre “mundano” pensar que podría “comenzar de nuevo”. Hoy celebramos el “octavo día”, cuando el Señor comienza nuevamente la creación, como resultado de la Tumba Vacía. Es símbolo de “nuevo comienzo” cuando el Señor manifiesta la aplicación del mérito de la Cruz en nuestras vidas. Se presenta completamente “nuevo” ante los Apóstoles en la misma sala donde instituyó el sacerdocio y la Santísima Eucaristía. Ahora Él dice: Paz; la ansiedad y el miedo ya no tienen cabida en el léxico de la condición humana: podemos empezar de nuevo, diariamente, en Él. Los laicos creen esto, la diferencia es que muchas veces dicen que el “poder” para empezar de nuevo se encuentra dentro de uno mismo, por el propio poder. El cristiano dice que el “poder” viene de Cristo. Cuando diariamente tomo mi cruz, mi obligación, mis responsabilidades y mis alegrías, Cristo puede renovarme, remodelarme, a Su propia imagen.
