## MUSIC AT SAINT PATRICK & SAINT JOHN

How is music chosen for Sunday Mass? Many texts are proper to the Mass, which helps somewhat with the planning process! An example of a "Proper" is the Communion antiphon – there is always a Communion antiphon, about one sentence long, that usually comes from the Gospel passage, but with a different text each week, which is what makes it proper (or specific) to that Sunday. The first reading, Psalm, second reading, and Gospel are other examples of proper texts. Each week, these readings will be said at Mass, but there is a different Biblical citation each week. How then to choose the music or the melody to which the Communion antiphon is set? This is a bit more complicated. There are a few ways to go about it. The end goal is to choose a melody that is beautiful, goes well with the words, and is singable for the choir as well as the congregation. The melody we sing each week is adapted from Benedictine monk, Fr. Samuel Weber, who composed music for the English language Entrance, Offertory, and Communion antiphons for the entire liturgical year, immediately following the Second Vatican Council.


