**THE PASTOR'S WEEKLY REFLECTION/ REFLEXIÓN SEMANAL DEL PASTOR**

Traditionally, the Feast of the Epiphany celebrates the triple mysteries of the revelation of the first of the signs of Our Lord in the Gospel of John, the changing of water to wine at the Wedding of Cana; the manifestation of the Christ Child to the world before the Magi; and the manifestation of the Divine Son to the world at the Baptism of the Lord. In the East, this is explicit in the liturgies of the Feast of the Epiphany. In the West it is implicit in the various prayers throughout the liturgies of the Mass and the Divine Office on the same day, and made explicit through the distinct celebrations of the Feast of the Epiphany and the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, which marks the end of the Christmas Season, opening the door to *ordered time*, "Ordinary Time."

Each day of Ordinary Time, not marked by a saints feast is a "feria day," a feast day to mark a new way for each of us to enter more fully into a life of discipleship.

As we shift to Ordinary Time, I challenge you to pick up the sacred scriptures each week, or if you already do that, to set some silent time before the Lord each day, whether in your home, or in the church, maybe consider praying at least a decade of the Rosary with your family before or after dinner, or maybe offer some intercessory prayer with your children before bed.

One of the formative moments for Pope Saint John Paul II was to witness his father praying silently, while kneeling before an image of Our Lady of Czestochowa.

Please be assured of my prayers this week.



Tradicionalmente, la Fiesta de la Epifanía celebra el triple misterio de la revelación del primero de los signos de Nuestro Señor en el Evangelio de Juan, la conversión del agua en vino en las Bodas de Caná; la manifestación del Niño Jesús al mundo ante los Magos; y la manifestación del Hijo Divino al mundo en el Bautismo del Señor. En Oriente, esto es explícito en las liturgias de la Fiesta de la Epifanía. En Occidente, está implícito en las diversas oraciones a lo largo de las liturgias de la Misa y el Oficio Divino en el mismo día, y se hace explícito a través de las distintas celebraciones de la Fiesta de la Epifanía y la Fiesta del Bautismo del Señor, que marca el final de la Temporada de Navidad, abriendo la puerta al tiempo ordenado, el "Tiempo Ordinario".

Cada día del Tiempo Ordinario, no marcado por una fiesta de los santos, es un "día de feria", un día de fiesta para marcar una nueva forma para que cada uno de nosotros entre más plenamente en una vida de discipulado.

Al pasar al Tiempo Ordinario, los desafío a que cada semana lean las Sagradas Escrituras o, si ya lo hacen, a que dediquen un tiempo de silencio ante el Señor cada día, ya sea en su casa o en la iglesia. Tal vez consideren rezar al menos una decena del Rosario con su familia antes o después de la cena, o tal vez ofrezcan una oración de intercesión con sus hijos antes de acostarse.

Uno de los momentos formativos para el Papa San Juan Pablo II fue presenciar a su padre rezando en silencio, arrodillado ante una imagen de Nuestra Señora de Czestochowa.

Tengan la seguridad de que esta semana los acompañaré en mis oraciones.
