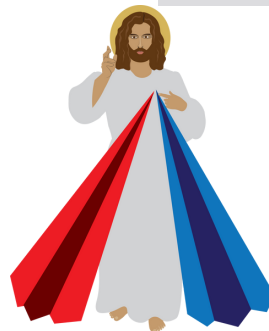

**THE PASTOR'S WEEKLY REFLECTION/ REFLEXIÓN SEMANAL DEL PÁRROCO****Surrexit Christus hodie**

Christ is Risen, today. The expression from the heart of the Church is a reminder that the accomplishment of the Paschal Mystery is an established fact, there is no formal argument against the history of the moment. The question for you and me is this: How will our life be challenged and changed as a result of the fact that Jesus Christ is alive? How does this fact challenge your life?

It is our faith that at the end of our life we will be faced by the Risen One, whether we choose to answer these questions in the here-and-now. One of the reasons I am Catholic today is because these questions unsettled me when I was younger. If He *is* Who he says He is I have to face that reality, or spend my life wondering if I am wrong. When I started to face those questions, my life began to change.

Together, let's face the Risen One and zealously embrace His Gospel message.

**MUSIC AT SAINT PATRICK AND SAINT JOHN**

*Resurrexit Dominus vere, Alleluia!  
The Lord is truly risen, Alleluia!*

Easter Sunday is one of only a few Sundays of the year that we get to experience the ancient tradition of the Sequence hymn. What is a Sequence? It is a hymn sung by the choir and/or congregation which is sandwiched between the Second Reading and the Alleluia and is a textual mediation on the Gospel about to be read. This adds to the solemnity of the Mass and the Church seems to be saying to us: "this Gospel is *very* important, and we don't want to let it pass us by without a pause to think about it!" The Easter Sequence, Christians to the Paschal Victim [*Victimae Paschali Laudes*], is one of the only Sequence hymns that follows an abnormal musical and poetic structure. Normally, the Sequence has an AABBCDD, etc. structure. The melody is sung twice (different words each time), then it moves on to a new melody, in the same way. You'll find, if you sing the Sequence at Mass this Sunday, that this hymn has a slightly different structure, with not as regular repetition.

May the Lord bless you this Easter Season!

**Cristo ha resucitado hoy**

Cristo ha resucitado hoy. Esta expresión, proveniente del corazón de la Iglesia, nos recuerda que la consumación del Misterio Pascual es un hecho establecido; no hay argumento formal en contra de la historia del momento. La pregunta para ti y para mí es esta: ¿Cómo se verá nuestra vida desafiada y transformada como resultado de la vida de Jesucristo? ¿Cómo reta este hecho a tu vida?

Creemos que al final de nuestra vida nos encontraremos con el Resucitado, ya sea que elijamos responder a estas preguntas aquí y ahora. Una de las razones por las que soy católico hoy es porque estas preguntas me inquietaron de joven. Si Él es quien dice ser, tengo que afrontar esa realidad o pasar la vida preguntándome si estoy equivocado. Cuando comencé a afrontar estas preguntas, mi vida empezó a cambiar.

Juntos, enfrentemos al Resucitado y abracemos con fervor su mensaje evangélico.

**MUSIC AT SAINT PATRICK AND SAINT JOHN**

*Resurrexit Dominus vere, Alleluia!  
!El Señor ha resucitado verdaderamente, aleluya!*

El Domingo de Pascua es uno de los pocos domingos del año en los que podemos experimentar la antigua tradición del himno de la Secuencia. ¿Qué es una Secuencia? Es un himno cantado por el coro y/o la congregación que se coloca entre la Segunda Lectura y el Aleluya, y que ofrece una meditación textual sobre el Evangelio que está a punto de proclamarse. Esto añade solemnidad a la Misa, y la Iglesia parece decirnos: "¡este Evangelio es muy importante y no queremos dejarlo pasar sin una pausa para reflexionar sobre él!"

La Secuencia de Pascua, Cristianos, ofreced al Cordero Pascual (*Victimae Paschali Laudes*), es uno de los pocos himnos de Secuencia que sigue una estructura musical y poética poco común. Normalmente, la Secuencia tiene una estructura AABBCDD, etc. La melodía se canta dos veces (con diferentes palabras cada vez), y luego se pasa a una nueva melodía de la misma manera. Verás, si cantas la Secuencia en la Misa este domingo, que este himno tiene una estructura un poco diferente, con repeticiones no tan regulares.

¡Que el Señor te bendiga en esta Temporada de Pascua!

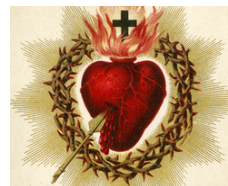
