THE PASTOR'S WEEKLY REFLECTION/ REFLEXIÓN SEMANAL DEL PÁRROCO

As most of you know, given last week's announcement, the Bishop determined in the current round of clergy assignments that I would be leaving the community of St. Peter, St. Patrick, and St. John and returning to the Pastoral Center full-time, to continue duties as the Judicial Vicar & Chancellor. I am striving to approach this new change as I have the last 14 years of priesthood: simple, joyful acceptance. You go where you are asked to serve, and you do it willingly, even if you might prefer to stay.

It's been a joy to serve you these last two years. Thank you to Fr. Redmond, the parish staff, and each of you for your generosity and welcome. We have beautiful little communities, and I look forward to the opportunity to serve you in a part-time fashion, if your new administrator sees it opportune.

I know that you will welcome Fr. Joseph Indadaño, JCL, to the parishes with warmth and your usual accommodation. Fr. Joseph currently works part-time in the Marriage Tribunal, as an ecclesiastical judge, and will continue to do so this coming year, one day a week. He is currently serving as Parochial Vicar of the Church of the Incarnation, Charlottesville and the mission of Holy Rosary, Crozet, so he is familiar with the needs of multiple communities and multiple assignments. In my personal experience, he has been a welcome, youthful addition to the Tribunal staff over the last year.

As I conclude my time with you, in the next couple weeks, please, no need to plan any departure gatherings, I'm just grateful to the Lord, and to you, to serve his local Church of Richmond.

Please be assured of my prayers this week.

Como la mayoría de ustedes sabe, tras el anuncio de la semana pasada, el Obispo determinó, en la ronda actual de asignaciones para el clero, que dejaría la comunidad de San Pedro, San Patricio y San Juan y regresaría al Centro Pastoral para ocuparme de mis funciones como Vicario Judicial y Canciller a tiempo completo. Me esfuerzo por afrontar este nuevo cambio como lo he hecho durante los últimos 14 años de sacerdocio: con una aceptación sencilla y gozosa. Uno va adonde se le pide servir y lo hace con gusto, incluso si prefiere quedarse.

Ha sido un placer servirles estos dos últimos años. Gracias al Padre Redmond, al personal de la parroquia y a cada uno de ustedes por su generosidad y bienvenida. Tenemos pequeñas y hermosas comunidades, y espero con ansias la oportunidad de servirles a tiempo parcial, si su nuevo administrador lo considera oportuno.

Sé que recibirán al Padre Joseph Indadaño, JCL, en las parroquias con calidez y su habitual hospitalidad. Joseph trabaja actualmente a tiempo parcial en el Tribunal Matrimonial como juez eclesiástico y continuará haciéndolo este año, un día a la semana. Actualmente se desempeña como vicario parroquial de la Iglesia de la Encarnación en Charlottesville y de la misión del Santo Rosario en Crozet, por lo que está familiarizado con las necesidades de diversas comunidades y asignaciones. En mi experiencia personal, ha sido una incorporación joven y bienvenida al personal del Tribunal durante el último año.

Al concluir mi tiempo con ustedes en las próximas semanas, por favor, no es necesario planear reuniones de despedida; simplemente estoy agradecido al Señor y a ustedes por servir a su Iglesia local de Richmond.

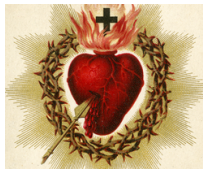
