#### THE ADMINISTRATOR'S WEEKLY REFLECTION/ REFLEXION SEMANAL DEL ADMINISTRATOR

In the gospel this Sunday, Jesus revealed the heart of prayer as a personal and trusting relationship with God. When the disciples asked Him to teach them how to pray, He did not give them a formula filled with lofty words—He gave them the Our Father, a simple yet powerful prayer that expressed our daily dependence on God. It reminds us that prayer is not just about asking for things, but about aligning our hearts with the will of the Father. Through prayer, we acknowledge God's holiness, seek His kingdom, ask for daily sustenance, forgiveness, and the strength to forgive. It is an act of humility, surrender, and trust.

Jesus then taught us the value of persistence in prayer. He shared to us the story of someone knocking on a friend's door at midnight, showing that prayer is not a one-time act but a continuous seeking, asking, and knocking. God is not distant or indifferent—He is a loving Father who hears every prayer, even those spoken in silence. When we persist, we demonstrate faith, hope, and a desire to grow closer to Him. And though God may not always answer in the way we expect, He promises to give what is best—especially the gift of the Holy Spirit. Prayer, then, is not just about changing our situation—it's about letting God change our hearts.

En el Evangelio de este domingo, Jesús revela que el corazón de la oración es una relación personal y confiada con Dios. Cuando los discípulos le pidieron que les enseñara a orar, Él no les dio una fórmula con palabras elevadas, sino que les dio el Padre Nuestro, una oración sencilla pero poderosa que expresa nuestra dependencia diaria de Dios. Nos recuerda que orar no es solo pedir cosas, sino alinear nuestro corazón con la voluntad del Padre. A través de la oración, reconocemos la santidad de Dios, buscamos su Reino, pedimos el pan de cada día, el perdón y la fuerza para perdonar. Es un acto de humildad, entrega y confianza.

Jesús también nos enseñó el valor de la perseverancia en la oración. Compartió la historia de alguien que toca a la puerta de un amigo a medianoche, mostrando que la oración no es un acto único, sino un constante buscar, pedir y llamar. Dios no está distante ni es indiferente — es un Padre amoroso que escucha cada oración, incluso aquellas que se elevan en silencio. Cuando perseveramos, demostramos fe, esperanza y deseo de acercarnos más a El. Y aunque Dios no siempre responda como esperamos, Él promete darnos lo mejor, especialmente el don del Espíritu Santo. La oración, entonces, no solo cambia nuestra situación — permite que Dios transforme nuestro corazón.


